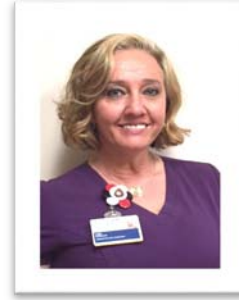

All newly-diagnosed breast cancer patient cases are presented at a weekly multidisciplinary breast conference. More than 20 physicians (surgeons, medical oncologists, radiation oncologists, radiologists, pathologists) as well as pharmacists, research nurses and breast clinic navigators review each case and suggest an initial treatment plan. Patients are given the option of being seen in the Breast Multidisciplinary Clinic or may choose to see a surgeon, medical oncologist and radiation oncologist individually.

Who you will see during a multi-disciplinary clinic appointment:

- Your individual team (surgeon, medical and radiation oncologist) to determine optimal overall treatment plan.
- Physical therapist to provide information to help minimize surgical side-effects.
- Health care professional from patient and family support team to offer
- comprehensive care for the body, mind and spirit.

What you will learn and take away:

- You will learn about your diagnosis, including type of cancer and stage.
- You will learn about the recommended treatments for your diagnosis.
- A printed summary plan of care.

Additional team members that you might meet:

- An onsite breast cancer survivor.
- Genetic Counselor.
- Nutritionist.

Once a month, the Greensboro Breast Cancer Working Group (all the physicians primarily involved in the care of Breast Cancer patients) meets to discuss new developments and controversies in the medical literature, evaluate new techniques and treatment options, and set up standards that will apply to all breast cancer cases in this breast program.





DESCRIPTION OF FACILITY: Outpatient services include radiation oncology, medical oncology, chemotherapy, blood product transfusions and the Risk Assessment Clinic for genetic screening. Since families experience cancer together, the CHCC offers a program of extensive education and support services for patients and their families.

DESCRIPTION OF FACILITY: A comprehensive breast diagnostic center performing digital and 3D tomographic screening mammography, breast ultrasound and breast MRI. Mammograms and ultrasound exams are performed on site. Radiologists with specialty expertise in breast imaging interpret studies and personally speak with all diagnostic patients at the time of their exam. Biopsies can be performed with ultrasound, stereotactic or 3D tomographic guidance, often on the same day. MRI exams are performed at affiliated sites, and the images are sent electronically to the Breast Center of Greensboro Imaging for interpretation. MRI guided biopsy is also available. Bone density screening can be performed at the time of the mammogram appointment.

DESCRIPTION OF FACILITY: The Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeons of Wake Forest Baptist Health are dedicated to providing the highest quality medical services through the integration of specialized programs which focus on improving the quality and performance of daily life activities. We offer individualized consultation to develop a reconstruction plan that is specific for your body shape, goals and desires. Reconstruction options include autologous reconstruction, in which your body tissue is used to recreate a breast. Expanders followed by implants are also an option. Delayed reconstruction is available if preferred or medical circumstances require additional cancer treatments such as radiation or chemotherapy. Breast reconstruction is achieved through plastic surgery techniques designed to restore a breast to near normal shape, appearance and size following a mastectomy. All surgeries are provided in the Greensboro area at certified medical facilities.
